The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.280 dated 03.10.2020, under Section 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Safidon, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that 06 grams and 14 miligrams of smack was allegedly recovered from him which is marginally higher than the threshold of 05 grams of small quantity. The petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act. He is in custody for about a month.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Harkishan states that although the petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act but there are other cases under various provisions of IPC pending against him.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the recovery being marginally above the small quantity,

petitioner is in custody for about a month, he is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
