[1] Learned DAG has produced in Court today order dated 28.12.2018 promoting the petitioner to the post of Additional Registrar, Co-operative Societies. The same is taken on record as Mark - 'A'. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. Learned DAG on instructions from Somvir Assistant, Office of Registrar Co-operative Societies, Haryana states that in view of the relief prayed for having been granted to the petitioner, the writ petition has become infructuous.

[2] Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the statement of learned DAG, he does not press the writ petition at this stage and the same may be disposed of as having become infructuous. However, liberty be granted to the petitioner to move an application for revival of the writ petition, in case cause survives.

[3] In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous with the liberty as prayed for.
