1. Against the recovery order dated 18th February, 2020, which is challenged in the present writ petition, following an earlier cancellation order dated 1st August, 2019, which is also challenged here, an appeal purportedly was filed by e-mail by the Petitioner on 16th April, 2020, a copy of which is at Annexure P-24.
2. Mr. Sahil Sharma, learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab appearing on behalf of the Respondents points out that the aforesaid appeal is not in the proper format and that if the Petitioner files a proper appeal in a time-bound manner, it will be considered in accordance with law.
3. In view of the above statement, it is directed that the Petitioner shall, within a period of ten days from today and, in any event, not later than 9th November, 2020 file a properly constituted appeal under Rule 44 of the Punjab Minor Mineral Rules, 2013 in accordance with law and if the appeal is so filed, such appeal will be decided as expeditiously as possible and, in any event, not later

than three months from the date of its filing. It will be open to the Petitioner to seek appropriate interim reliefs in the said appeal.

4. The writ petition is disposed of in the above terms.
