The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.107 dated 29.05.2020, registered under Sections 323, 452, 342, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 304, 325, 442 IPC added later) at Police Station Dharmkot, District Moga.

The operative part of the order dated 28.10.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Relies upon order dated 28.08.2020 passed in CRM-M-24824- 2020 titled as Jaspal Singh @ Pala vs. State of Punjab (Annexure P-15) to submit that the role of the petitioner is similar to the role of the accused in the said petition and thus, he may be granted interim bail.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab accepts notice and

waives service.

The petitioner is directed to join investigation with the Investigating Officer on 09.11.2020 at 10.00 a.m. and cooperate therewith. In the event of his arrest, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/SHO concerned subject to his compliance of the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Adjourned to 26.11.2020....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 28.10.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from the Investigating Officer and assisted by counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 28.10.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
