Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of interim regular bail in case FIR No.466 dated 05.05.2018 registered under Section 20 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Thanesar, District Kurukshetra for taking care of his ailing father.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner's father is suffering from ailments and requires medical attention. He has invited the attention of the Court to the certificate dated 26.09.2020 issued by Nursing Home, which shows that his father remained admitted for three days, who is suffering from diabetes and chronic kidney disease. He prays for interim regular bail for two months.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jai Kishan has stated that prosecution has examined all its witnesses and the case is pending for recording the defence evidence.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by Mr. Baweja, learned counsel that the petitioner has five brothers, who are not involved in

dependent upon the petitioner alone, as his other sons can very well look after him.

Considering the above background of the case, no case is made out for releasing the petitioner on interim regular bail.

Petition is dismissed.
