Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that petitioner be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the respondents for the grant of the relief of the correct fixation of the pensionary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he is not pressing his claim for the grant of promotion and will not represent on that account to the respondent also. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner will file a representation claiming correct fixation of pensionary benefits only.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State that in case the petitioner filed any representation raising grievances with regard to the fixation of the pension, the same will be dealt with in accordance with the facts and of this

case coupled with settled principle of law within a period of three months of receipt of this Order by passing appropriate speaking order.

Keeping in the above stated fact, the petitioner is allowed to withdraw the present writ petition to exercise the liberty as prayed for.
