The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.113 dated 05.10.2020 under Sections 21/22 NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga.

Pursuant to order dated 17.11.2020 of this Court, Mr. Jagatpreet Singh, S.P. Moga is present through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 17.11.2020 of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhdeep Singh, does not dispute the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required. She further submits that there is no other case pending against the petitioner under the NDPS Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation and her custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 17.11.2020 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
