The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in DDR No. 35 dated 05.07.2020, under Sections 323, 324, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Sections 325 and 326 IPC added subsequently), registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, in FIR No. 237 dated 05.07.2020, under Sections 452, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC (Sections 325 and 326 IPC added subsequently), registered at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that members of opposite party had entered the house of petitioner No. 2 and had caused injuries to several persons, including petitioners No. 1, 2, 4 and 5, for which FIR was registered by petitioner No. 2. He has referred to the copy of MLRs of the injured at Annexures P2 to P6. He also contends that the injuries, which are attributed to the petitioners, are simple in nature except an injury on the finger of the injured which was found to be grievous.

This Court, by the order dated 29.10.2020, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Pawan Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 29.10.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
