The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 188 dated 10.09.2020, under Sections 323, 325, 452, 148 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No. 3, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is the outcome of a sudden quarrel in which injuries were received by both the sides. The daughter of the petitioner was also injured in the occurrence and a DDR has been lodged in that regard. He has referred to the copy of the DDR at Annexure P3.

This Court, by order dated 29.10.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Madan Lal, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 29.10.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
