Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.307 dated 08.03.2020 under Sections 307, 323, 379-B, 506, 120-B 34 IPC, registered at Police Station City Thanesar, District Kurukshetra.

On 05.11.2020, following order was passed by this Court: -

“During the course of hearing, it has been pointed out by learned Counsel for the petitioner that matter has been compromised inter se between the parties.

In view of the above, learned State Counsel seeks time to

have instructions from the concerned quarter.

On her request, adjourned to 21.12.2020.

Since co-accused, namely, Amandeep @ Aman has been granted interim bail by this Court, therefore, let petitioner be also released on interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter stands compromised between the parties as per the compromise deed dated 21.08.2020.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factum of compromise.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, in view of the fact that the matter stands compromise between the parties, this petition is allowed and the order dated 05.11.2020 passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute.
