The petitioner herein seeks appropriate directions to be issued to the respondent to examine the main witnesses at the earliest in proceedings pending in FIR No.198 dated 20.12.2015, registered under Sections 306, 201, 217, 218, 465, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Civil Line Batala, District Gurdaspur.

For the first time, the matter was taken up on 23.07.2019, on which date counsel for the petitioner sought time to place on record certain documents to support his arguments and the matter stood adjourned to 20.09.2019. On 20.09.2019, no one put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner and in the interest of justice, the matter stood adjourned for 28.02.2020 viz. today.

Today, despite the matter being called twice, there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner nor has the order dated 23.07.2019

been complied with.

Under these circumstances, it appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant matter. As such, the instant petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
