Case is taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This Court vide order dated 06.10.2020, while disposing of CRWP-7978-2020 filed by the petitioner, extended his parole upto 28.10.2020. The relevant part of the said order would read as under:-

“The petitioner is already on parole on medical ground. Keeping in view the medical status of his parents, the parole granted to the petitioner on medical ground is extended upto 28.10.2020. The petitioner would report back to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ferozepur on 28.10.2020 at 3.00 p.m. It is made clear that in case the petitioner does not surrender on

28.10.2020, coercive action shall be taken against him.”

A perusal of the file would show that the present petition was filed in the Registry of this Court on 27.10.2020. Thus, the present petition had been filed even before the compliance of the order dated 06.10.2020, which required the petitioner to surrender by 28.10.2020 at 3.00 p.m, before the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ferozepur.

The petitioner did not file any application for extension of the parole in the writ petition wherein the order dated 06.10.2020 was passed. Thus, no indulgence can be granted to the petitioner in a fresh petition filed by him unless the order dated 06.10.2020 is complied with.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed as premature.
