Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

The petitioner has filed this petition for issuance of necessary
directions to respondent No.2-SSP, Moga to protect the life and liberty of
the petitioner and his family members from the hands of respondents No.4
to 6, with further direction to respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioner
and his family members by calling them time and again to the police station.
In the petition, the petitioner has also alleged that respondent No.3 being
incharge of Police Post, Charik, District Moga, has asked the petitioner to
withdraw representations (Annexure P-1) and (Annexure P-2) or otherwise
to face dire consequences.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that he has already given
complaint/representation (Annexure P-2) to respondent No.2 but no action
has been taken on the same by respondent No.2.

Status report by way of affidavit of Barjinder Singh, DSP, City,

Moga on behalf of respondent No.1 has been filed which is taken on record. As per the said report, proceedings under Section 107 and 150 of Cr.P.C. were initiated against respondents No.4 to 6 but finally, the same were ordered to be consigned by respondent No.3.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner has made submission that he will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide his representation (Annexure P-2). Learned State counsel is also having no objection if such direction is issued to respondent No.2.

In the light of the aforesaid, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide complaint/representation dated 16.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner, as per law, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
