This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondent No.2 to pass a comprehensive and detailed order on the complaint dated 16.1.2020 (Annexure P-1) and the extended complaint dated 16.3.2020 (Annexure P-2)

It is submitted by the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is having grievance against the illegal action of the respondent No.3 and in that regard the petitioner had even made representation to respondents No.1 and 2. However, the respondents have not decided the representation dated 16.1.2020 and the extended representation dated 16.3.2020, moved by the petitioner against the action of the respondent No.3. On the last date of hearing, the counsel for the State had sought time to get instructions. However, still no action has been taken by the respondents on the representation of the petitioner.

It is also submitted by the counsel that, at this stage, the petitioner would be

satisfied if the respondents are directed to take action on representation Annexure P-1, read with extended representation at Annexure P-2, which were sent by the petitioner through his counsel, and to take a decision thereon qua the aspect of the leave of the petitioner.

The counsel appearing on behalf of the State also does not have any objection to expeditious disposal of the representations of the petitioner. Rather, it is submitted that the matter is under consideration of the respondent department.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to take a conscious decision on the representation of the petitioner at Annexure P-1 read with extended representation at Annexure P-2 and to pass a speaking order thereon within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
