Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to official respondents to register a case against the private respondents for alleged commission of offence of forgery who prepared false sale deed to grab the property.

Learned counsel has argued that the private respondents are making attempts to forcibly dispossess the petitioner on the basis of forged sale deed and a complaint dated 20.06.2020 given by her to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana has not been looked into so far as no FIR has been registered. He prays that the direction be issued to the official respondents for registration of the FIR.

After hearing the learned counsel, this Court finds that petitioner is sister in-law of Bharat Rai (respondent No.3) and is in possession of third floor of the property in question. The complaint (Annexure P-3) contains no averment that the petitioner is owner of the property. Apart from it, the petitioner can avail alternative remedy in

accordance with law, therefore, this Court finds no reason to exercise the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
