1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 10 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful disobedience of order (Annexure P/1) dated 20.02.2020 in CWP No.4713 of 2020.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of failure of the respondents to decide the claim raised by way of legal notice dated 16.10.2018 in terms of order dated 20.02.2020 in CWP No.4713 within 03 months of receipt of certified copy of aforesaid order, the instant contempt petition was filed but on 01.12.2020, the petitioner was supplied copy of order dated 25.11.2020, passed by the respondents, holding the petitioner entitled to financial benefits and in view thereof the petitioner

does not press the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of, as such, while directing the respondents to release payment to him as per entitlement, as determined by the respondents, vide order dated 25.11.2020 in pursuance of order dated 20.02.2020 in CWP No.4713 of 2020 in a time bound manner.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents states that in case the petitioner contacts respondent No.2 and complete requisite formalities, payment as per entitlement would be released to him within 04 weeks from the date of completion of formalities.

5. Accordingly, in the light of statement of learned counsel for the parties, the Contempt Petition is ***disposed of*** as not pressed in view of the assurance held out by learned counsel for the respondents.
