Through the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner prays for issuance of writ in the nature of certiorari to *set aside* the notification framed by the respondents on 07.11.2007 (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion.

On advance notice, Mr. Namit Kumar, Advocate appears on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the very outset prays that the respondents be directed to take a reasoned decision on his representations in view of provisions of Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation, Act 1995 and Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

We find it to be a fair request.

In the circumstances, the petition is disposed of at this stage, with a direction to respondent No.2-The Estate Officer, UT Chandigarh, to decide the representation (Annexures P-4 and P-5) within a period of one month by passing a speaking order thereon.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil
Miscellaneous Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
