CRM-M-34722-2020

This is a petition for regular bail filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, in case FIR No.206 dated 17.04.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 307, 323, 324, 326, 452, 506 and 302 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh.

[2]. The petitioner has remained in detention in the present case for more than 1 year and 7 months, since 27.04.2019.

[3]. Co-accused Shokat Ali has already been granted bail by this Court on 05.10.2020. Such release of the co-accused was in view of the fact

that the actual complainant in the case, who was examined as PW-6, had turned hostile and did not support the prosecution case pertaining to the alleged murder of his own son, namely, Robin.

[4]. In her statement as PW-5, victim Khurshidan has deposed that the present petitioner had assaulted her in the abdomen with knife, after which she was hospitalized for a long time.

[5]. In these circumstances, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, but in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner and the fact that the trial is likely to take its own considerable time due to ongoing Covid-19 Pandemic, as such, the prayer of the petitioner for his release on regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
