Petitioners have approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 20, who are against the love marriage of the son of petitioner No. 1.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that son of petitioner No.1 solemnized marriage on 01.10.2020 with one Amarjit Kaur against the wishes of private respondents. Due to threat perception, son of petitioner No.1 and Amarjit Kaur had filed a protection petition before this Court and this Court had disposed of the same vide order dated 15.10.2020. After passing of the order, son of petitioner No.1 started living separately with his wife and did not come back. He submits that since then private respondents are regularly harassing and threatening the petitioners i.e. mother and sister of the bridegroom.

3. In these circumstances, petitioners submitted a representation dated 24.10.2020 to respondent No.2, but the same has not been adverted.

4. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) to look into the complaint/representation dated 24.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) and ascertain/verify the threat perception of the petitioners. If warranted, necessary steps would be taken in accordance with law.

5. With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition stands disposed of.
