Petitioners have approached this Court under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondents No.2 and 3 to protect their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 is a widow lady and her son petitioner No.2 is a young boy of 23 years. When the husband of petitioner No.1 namely Gurmeet Singh was alive, respondents No.4 to 7 tried to grab the land of the petitioners. Civil litigation continued between the parties for number of years and the said civil litigation was decided in favour of the predecessor in interest of the petitioners.

3. On 03.10.2020, when the petitioners went to their agricultural land along with labourers to make arrangements for harvesting the crop then respondents No.4 to 7 along with 10-12 unidentified persons came to the spot along with weapons started threatening and abusing the petitioners.

4. He further submits that in these circumstances, petitioners submitted representation dated 03.10.2020 to respondent No.3 followed by another representation dated 05.10.2020 to respondent No.2, but the same have not been adverted till date.

5. Without commenting anything on the merits of the case, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana to look into the representation dated 03.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) and ascertain/verify the threat perception of the petitioners. If warranted, necessary steps would be taken in accordance with law.

6. With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition stands disposed of.
