The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 311 dated 10.08.2020, under Section 436 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is a delay of nine days in registering the FIR wherein it is alleged that the accused had put some inflammable substance in the shop of the complainant and a blast had taken place resulting in a loss of ₹6,00,000/-. He, however, contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated, as it is alleged that the petitioner had told some person that he had gone towards the shop during night hours and that person had informed the complainant in that regard. However, the name of that person has not been mentioned.

This Court, by the order dated 29.10.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail

to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Sandeep Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 29.10.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
