The petitioner has approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR (Annexure P-1) on the ground that the matter has been compromised amongst the parties.

At this stage, Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2-complainant and has endorsed the fact that the parties have indeed compromised the matter.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas raised herein before the learned trial Court at appropriate stage.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. Needless to mention, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise specific plea before the learned

trial Court to the effect that the FIR has been registered under some misunderstanding which has now been resolved. It is further clarified that in case any such plea is taken at the time of filing of an application seeking grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall dispose off the said application expeditiously while considering the aforesaid plea.
