In compliance of order dated 29.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced receipts of ₹20,000/-. The same are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.20 dated 19.03.2015, registered under Sections 467, 468, 471, 420 IPC, at Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, order dated 15.07.2017 (Annexure P-2) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-3) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 23.07.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 15.10.2019 to get their statements recorded.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sri Muktsar Sahib, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.474 dated 18.10.2019, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Muktsar, vide Endst. No.2133/EB dated 22.10.2019.

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is genuine and valid and without any pressure or coercion.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.20 dated 19.03.2015, registered under Sections 467, 468, 471, 420 IPC, at Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, order dated 15.07.2017 (Annexure P-2) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.
