The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondents not to finalise the tender notice dated 14.7.2020 (Annexure P6) till the final decision on the representation of the petitioner for extension of time.

Contentends that in violation of the undertaking made before this Court in CWP-13639-2020, decided on 4.9.2020 (Annexure P10) and without deciding the legal notice dated 22.9.2020 (Annexure P15) filed by the petitioner for extension of time, the fresh tender has been circulated.

The petitioner is still executing the work under the old tender. Learned

counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, he will be satisfied, in case the legal notice dated 22.9.2020 (Annexure P15) issued by the petitioner in pursuance of judgment dated 4.9.2020 passed in CWP-13639-2020 is decided before allotting the fresh tender to any other party.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has already been handed over to the learned State counsel.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, we direct respondent No.2 Engineer-in-Chief (Roads), Haryana, PWD B&R Department, Haryana to decide the legal notice dated 22.9.2020 (Annexure P15) served by the petitioner before finalisation/ allotment of tender to any other party.

Disposed of accordingly.
