This petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of an appropriate writ or direction to respondents No. 1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of private respondents No. 4 to 8 and also to restrain the private respondents from performing the marriage of petitioner without her consent.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only. At the asking of Court, Mr. Sukhbeer Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paperbook has been supplied to him.

Having considered the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and perusal of record, and the fact that the petitioner is major, respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, District Bathinda, is directed to consider the representation dated 20.10.2020

(Annexure P/2) and issue necessary orders, as warranted by law, so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondents.

With the above said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
