1. Counsel for the State of Punjab has handed over across a short affidavit of the Excise and Taxation Officer, Office of Assistant Excise and Taxation Commissioner, Pathankot dated 16th March, 2020, stating, inter alia, that the liquor Vend, in question, is being shifted approximately 500 meters away from its present location in consonance with the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and Excise Policy 2019-2020. It is further stated that “the said shifting has been done and the same is being done at the satisfaction of the petitioner and villagers.”
