The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.186 dated 21.09.2020 under Sections 307, 341, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Boha District Mansa.

It is not in dispute that there is a counter FIR No.185 of even date lodged by the petitioners' side. In the present case, the alleged firing was done by accused Simrat Singh hitting driver side window of car of Jassi Singh. None was injured in the present case.

Notice of motion was issued on 30.10.,2020 along with interim order of stay of arrest.

In view of version and cross-version and case of no injury on both sides, I deem it appropriate to direct the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer to join investigation on 07.12.2020 and in the event of their arrest, they shall be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C:-

- i) that the petitioners shall make themselves available for interrogation before the Investigating Officer as and when required;
- ii) that the petitioners shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- iii) that the petitioners shall not leave the country, without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender their passports, if any.
