The case has been taken up for hearing
through video conferencing.

The petitioner has preferred this writ petition for the issuance of appropriate writ, order of direction, especially in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant the seniority and other service benefits as per merit in the batch along with interest. The grievance of the petitioner is that he has not been granted seniority and other monetary benefits at par with candidates who were selected along with the petitioner in the same selection and were appointed in the year 2011 and 2012.

Learned counsel for the petitioner alleged that the case of similarly situated employee namely Sukhwinder Singh has been granted the requisite benefit in **CWP No. 21716**

of 2013 titled Sukhwinder Singh Vs. State of Punjab and Others. Precisely for the grievance in question, the petitioner has already got issued a legal notice dated 04.02.2020 to the Director General of Police, Punjab and the same has not been adverted to as yet.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case his legal notice is decided within a time bound manner in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Anju Arora, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent/State.

Legal notice dated 04.02.2020 is directed to be decided by the respondent No.2 in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of the order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
