This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus thereby directing the respondents to issue consent to establish and operate under Environmental Protection Act and as well as under both Air and Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act with time bound frame in pursuance to the communications/applications 6.6.2006 (Annexures P-8, P-9 and P-10)
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in fact during the pendency of this writ petition respondent No.2 has offered hearing on 24.11.2020 and restricted his prayer only to direct respondent no.2 to decide the matter in accordance with law within a reasonable time.
3. Counsel for the respondent No.2 has very fairly accepted this prayer.

4. In the circumstances, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner by passing a reasoned order within two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
5. Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any(s), also stands disposed of.
