Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.89 dated 13.10.2018 registered under Sections 452, 354, 323, 506, 34 of IPC at Police Station Women, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 05.12.2019 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has argued that there is an affidavit Annexure P-4 (vernacular) wherein the signature of the complainant were obtained on the plea of some pension papers.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and the fact as to whether thumb-impressions were taken on

on the pretext of pension or otherwise, is a matter to be adjudicated during trial.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manoj, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 05.12.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
