This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed seeking issuance of directions to the official respondents to ensure protection of the life and liberty of the petitioners by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

Counsel has been heard and pleadings on record have been perused.

As per averments made in the petition, petitioner No.1 was married to respondent No.4 in the year 2016. She has now chosen to leave the matrimonial home and is in a live in relationship with petitioner No.2.

There is no decree of divorce and petitioner No.1 even as of date would be seen as the legally wedded wife of respondent No.4.

Under no circumstances would this Court approve of the relationship/liaison between the petitioners.

The pleadings on record are wholly insufficient for this

court to interfere any imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

No intervention is called for.

Petition dismissed.
