This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to look into the conduct of local bodies, who are allegedly violating the policy of Transport of Food Grains 2019-2021, laid by the department of Food Supply, Punjab as well as contravening the provisions of Motor Vehicle Rules/Act and policies of Transport of Department of Transport Punjab. Violation of order dated 08.03.2019 in CWP No. 11685 of 2015 (Annexure P-2) is also alleged.

However, when faced with the question of locus standi of the petitioner to file this writ petition, learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to persuade this Court to interfere.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage, seeks to withdraw this writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail the remedy/ remedies as may be available to him in accordance with law, including that of filing a petition in public interest, if maintainable.

Petition is accordingly dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforementioned. Needless to say, there is no expression of opinion on the merits of the controversy or maintainability of a petition in public interest.
