The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed, *inter alia*, for the issuance of a direction to the respondents to hear the review application dated 17.08.2019 (Annexure P-8), preferred by the petitioner.

Learned counsel states that the review application preferred by the petitioner is pending adjudication before respondent No.4. At this stage, he would be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to respondent No.4- Presiding Officer, Election Tribunal-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur, to consider and decide the review application (Annexure P-8), in a time-bound manner.

Heard.

Considering the nature of prayer made, we are not inclined to issue notice of motion. A complete copy of the paper-book has already been supplied to learned State counsel.

Accordingly, without adverting to the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction that order in the review application be passed by respondent No.4-Presiding Officer, Election Tribunal-cum-Sub Divisional Magistrate, Guruharsahai, District Ferozepur after affording effective opportunity of hearing to the petitioner in the next three hearings within a period of eight weeks from today.
