1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0236, dated 22.07.2019, registered under Section 4 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 and Sections 376 & 506 IPC at Police Station Bawani Khera, District Bhiwani.
3. Learned State Counsel states that all the prosecution witnesses have been examined and that in the circumstances, petition can be disposed of by directing the learned trial Court to conclude the trial expeditiously.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would examine witnesses in defence expeditiously but in the circumstances, the learned trial Court be directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.

petition is ***disposed of*** by directing the learned trial Court to conclude the trial, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible on conclusion of examination of defence witnesses by the petitioner while keeping in mind the period of time stipulated under Section 35, Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.
