This is a petition filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India, with a prayer to issue appropriate writ with direction to the respondents to grant increment to the petitioner from the due date with all consequential benefits and also to promote him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that that the petitioner was an Ex-serviceman and more than 45 years of age at the time of recruitment and he has referred to Annexure P-3, where it is mentioned that the person who is 45 years and above, he should be completely exempted from typing test. Learned counsel argues that increment was not granted to the petitioner on the ground that he did not pass his typing test. Learned counsel has further submitted that he had issued a legal notice dated 05.10.2020 (Annexure P-9), but the same has not been decided by the respondents.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Rajiv Goyal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner had served legal notice to the respondents, therefore, without calling upon the respondents at this stage and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide legal notice dated 05.10.2020 (Annexure P-9) by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from today. Thereafter, copy of the order shall also be supplied to the petitioner by way of registered post.
