1. This is an application on behalf of the Petitioner seeking leave to place on record the affidavit directed to be filed by the Court by its order dated 30th October, 2020.
2. For the reasons stated therein, the application is allowed. The affidavit is taken on record.

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3. The Petitioner is essentially aggrieved by the assessment order dated 30th September, 2020 of the Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Gurugram. The aforesaid order was issued pursuant to an order dated 25th September, 2020 of the Transport Commissioner, Haryana, whereby it was directed that the permit issued to the Petitioner on 29th December, 2017 which had inadvertently mentioned 'all Haryana', should be corrected to reflect that it was issued for only one route i.e. Gurugram to

Petitioner's vehicle be re-assessed by the Regional Transport Authority, Gurugram.

4. In view of the fact that the assessment order dated 30th September, 2020 is appealable under Section 18 of the Haryana Motor Vehicles Taxation Act, 2016, the Court disposes of the writ petition by permitting the Petitioner to challenge the above impugned order of re-assessment in accordance with law.
