The case has been taken up through video conferencing on account of Covid-2019 pandemic.

Prayer is for grant of bail in case FIR No.111, dated 25.07.2020 under Sections 307, 324, 323 and 34 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa, Punjab.

The FIR in the present case was registered on the statement of Raj Kaur, complainant. She stated that her husband has two brothers and a sister, who are married. Her brother-in-law Gurjeet Singh is bachelor. Her husband Hardeep Singh is a Granthi in Singh Gurdwara Sahib, Himmatpura near village Bachoanna.. It is stated that she had married to Hardeep Singh about six years back. After her marriage, she was harassed by the family of her in-laws because of which, she went to her parents house but later on request of her husband she came back to the house of her in-laws because of which her father-in-law Darshan Singh

and brother-in-law Gurjeet Singh were not happy. On 03.07.2020, at about 8.00 a.m. in the morning, her son Harpreet Singh after verbally abusing her ran towards her father in law's room. She ran behind him then Gurjet Singh came out of the courtyard with Gandasa in his hand and hit the wife of the complainant with Gandasa twice. Meanwhile, Darshan Singh (petitioner) also came out. He got hold of the Gandasa from the brother-in-law of the complainant and struck on her posterior's right side as well as on right arm. Gurjeet Singh took up a danda lying nearby and hit right arm's elbow of the complainant and father-in-law Darshan Singh hit left arm with the opposite side of the Gandasa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that the matter has been compromised between the parties. The affidavit of the complainant and the compromise deed has been annexed as Annexures P-2 and P-3, respectively.

Learned State counsel states that the challan has been presented and investigation of the case is complete.

In view thereof, this petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Mansa.
