Prayer in the instant application is for withdrawal of the main writ petition. Application is supported by an affidavit of the sole petitioner namely Rattan Lal Verma son of Sh. Manohar Lal.

It may be noticed that challenge in the main writ petition was to an order dated 22.11.2013 (Annexure P-12) whereby while serving on the post of Senior Assistant under the Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Limited, petitioner had been compulsorily retired from service.

In the light of the prayer made in the application for withdrawal of the writ petition there would be no requirement of issuing notice to the respondent-Corporation.

Since the application is supported by an affidavit of the petitioner himself and the main writ petition which stands admitted, is taken on Board today itself.

Application is disposed of.

Main case

Counsel for the petitioner makes a statement at the Bar that he

has instructions from the petitioner not to pursue the instant writ petition.

Similar is the prayer of the sole petitioner in terms of CM No.779 of 2020.

In view of the above, writ petition is disposed of as not pressed
