The prayer of the petitioner, a daily wage worker in the service of the Punjab School Education Board, is to set aside the order dated 27.03.2018 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Board, terminating his services.

It may be noted that this Court, following the judgment of the Supreme Court in **'Uttaranchal Forest Development Corporation and another V/s. Jabar Singh and others'** [2007(2) SCT 458] relegated the petitioners in a batch of cases, who were also daily wagers in the service of the Board, to the alternative remedy under the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, in relation to their grievance with regard to their termination /retrenchment from service.

A copy of the said order dated 09.08.2018 passed in various miscellaneous applications filed in CWP No.7521 of 2018 and batch, is placed on record.

As the petitioner is also aggrieved by his termination from service by way of the order dated 27.03.2018, his remedy would be before the jurisdictional Labour Court.

The writ petition is accordingly dismissed on this short ground leaving it open to the petitioner to avail the statutory remedy before the competent forum in accordance with law.

Interim order dated 20.07.2018 shall stand vacated.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall also stand dismissed.
