The instant writ petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to allow the petitioners to join on various posts, being eligible and selected candidates.

Counsel for the petitioners herein would contend that the petitioners were duly recommended by the agency Citadel Security Services (Service Provider) for appointment on the said posts, pursuant to an advertisement that was issued. It is further submitted that even the Director, Development and Panchayat, Haryana, Chandigarh, has asked the Chief Executive Officer, Zila Parishad, Kaithal to ensure their joining, but as on date, they have not been allowed to join. It is also submitted that a legal notice dated 27.08.2020 (Annexure P-10) has already been served

upon the respondents, but the same has not been decided. At the present moment, counsel for the petitioners limits his prayer to the extent that legal notice dated 27.08.2020 (Annexure P-10) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. S.S. Pannu, DAG Haryana, who is appearing through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that respondents will look into the matter and will decide the legal notice of the petitioners.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 27.08.2020 (Annexure P-10) of the petitioners within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
