This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed by petitioner Chetan Prashar, aged about 28 years, against the respondents i.e. State of Punjab and 04 others, craving for issuance of a direction to respondents No.3 and 4 not to unnecessarily harass him on account of complaints filed by respondent No.5 and to comply with provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C.
