Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued the matter at length, but has not been able to convince the Court. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw this petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, concerned. Directions may only be issued to decide the bail application within a limited time frame.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The petitioner shall be at liberty to surrender before the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, concerned and move an application for regular bail. In case, such an application is filed, the concerned Illaqa/Duty

Magistrate shall decide the same within a period of 10 days from the date of filing of application.
