The petitioner appeared for the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (UG)-2020 on 13.09.2020. Cause for grievance, ventilated by way of this writ petition, is her suspicion that her OMR answer sheet was substituted. By order dated 06.11.2020 passed in this writ petition, this Court directed the original OMR answer sheet of the petitioner to be produced in a sealed cover.

Today, Mr. Arun Gosain, learned Senior Government Counsel for Union of India, produced the original OMR answer sheet of the petitioner in a sealed cover. Perusal thereof reflects that there is no overwriting in any part thereof. The admitted Roll Number of the petitioner, viz., 1601110269, has been shown correctly in numericals as well as by blacking out numbers. The OMR answer sheet also bears the name and signature of the petitioner at the bottom. In the light of this document, the apprehension of the petitioner that there was any foul-play with her answer sheet stands settled.

The writ petition is devoid of merit and is accordingly dismissed.

The original OMR answer sheet is again re-sealed and shall be returned to Ms. Sarika Soam, Legal Consultant with the National Testing Agency.
