Hearing of the case was held through video conference on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuing appropriate directions to respondents no.1 to 3 not to harass the petitioner in FIR No. 0208, dated 08.09.2020, registered under Section 346 IPC, at Police Station City Jhajjar, District Jhajjar. The petitioner claims that she troubled by her husband-Satyander-respondent no.4 herein, left the matrimonial home on her own and started living in Gurugram. She further claims that she is being harassed by the police at the behest of her husband.

Sh. Chetan Sharma, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, has pointed out that the petitioner has not filed the present petition by disclosing material facts. It has been brought to the notice of the court that the petitioner is residing with one Aarif Khan @ Tarik Hussain after having

performed second marriage with him during the subsistence of first marriage.

On being confronted, learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute correctness of these facts.

Thus, it is obvious that the petitioner has filed the petition by concealing material facts from the Court.

In these circumstances, this court is left with no choice but to dismiss the petition with costs of Rs.50,000/- which shall be deposited within a period of 3 months with the 'Poor Patients Welfare Fund' of the Post-graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh, personally or through its website “www.pgimer.edu.in” and produce the receipt duly verified by his counsel before the Registrar General of this Court.
