The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.201 dated 14.10.2020, under Sections 420, 506 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations are primarily against her husband, who is alleged to have taken money to get a job for the complainant. The petitioner has been involved because she is the wife of co-accused Kamaldeep Singh.

This Court, by the order dated 03.11.2020, had directed petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and she having joined investigation, the order dated 03.11.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
