It is not in dispute that the appeal filed by the Municipal Council, Nangal is pending before the Central Government Industrial Tribunal. The petitioner-Society is a Contractor working for Municipal Council. It claims that no EPF could be deducted by the Municipal Council and the Act is not applicable to the petitioner-Society..

Since, the appeal filed by the Municipal Council, Nangal on the same issue is pending before the Central Government Industrial Tribunal, therefore, it is considered appropriate to relegate the petitioner to the aforesaid remedy. The petitioner shall be at liberty to move an application for becoming a party or an intervenor in the pending appeal which shall be considered and decided by the Central Government Industrial Tribunal in accordance with law.

With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.
