GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.80, dated 24.6.2019, Police Station Rohadai, District Rewari, Haryana, under Sections 147, 148, 323, 324, 452, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 22.8.2019, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)-cum-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kosli, has been received, wherein it

has been reported that statements of petitioners/accused Manoj, Sudhir @ Munni, Manjeet, Usha Devi, Ankit Kumar, Sunita, Nirmala Devi and also of complainant Amarjeet, injured Renu, Jyoti, Ranbir, eye witness Balwan Singh, Krishan, Rajender Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant/injured in their statements have specifically stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division)-cum-Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Kosli, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.80, dated 24.6.2019, Police Station Rohadai, District Rewari, Haryana, under Sections 147, 148, 323, 324, 452, 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
