Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the selection which has been made by the respondents to the post of Constable in pursuance to the advertisement No. 8 of 2015 dated 19.07.2015 is not in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that not only this, there are certain posts lying vacant, which are not being filled by the respondents, which is causing prejudice to the petitioners and a reliance is placed on a letter written by the Director General of Police, Haryana to the Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission on 14.09.2020 (Annexure P-10).

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners intend to file a comprehensive representation with the respondents bringing out the irregularities committed by the respondents-Commission while making the selection to the post of Constable and the

respondents be directed to decide the said representation expeditiously by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that in case, any representation is submitted by the petitioners, the same will be decided in accordance with law within a period of two months from the receipt of the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that statement given by the learned counsel for the respondents-State is acceptable to the petitioners.

Keeping in view the above, without going into the merits of the case or the claim being raised by the petitioner in this petition, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents that in case, the petitioner submits any representation to the respondents-Commission, the same be decided in accordance with law within a period of two months of the submission of the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.
