This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 5 dated 31.5.2019 under Sections 7,13 (2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act read with Section 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Bathinda.

Interim order was passed on 16.11.2019 vide which the petitioner was directed to surrender before the Investigating Officer and join the proceedings.

Admittedly, the petitioner has joined the proceedings. In the statement of the complainant under Section 164 Cr.P.C.. the complainant has not supported the case of the prosecution.

In view of above, interim order dated 16.11.2019 is

made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
