This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C with a prayer to call for the status report in a criminal complaint/representations filed on 1.5.2018 and 16.9.2020.

It has been pleaded by the petitioner that he is the owner in possession of shop bearing no. 1239/8x-2011 constructed over a plot measuring 10 marla. It has been pleaded that the petitioner filed a civil suit in which an injunction was granted in his favour, however, the petitioner withdrew the same on 9.3.2018. The petitioner claims that he had filed a complaint on which the police is not taking any action. It has further been pleaded that Bhupinder Singh filed a criminal complaint alleging himself to be a nephew of Gurcharan Singh which was also dismissed and the aforesaid order was upheld in the revision.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court does not find

it appropriate to exercise jurisdiction under Section 482 Cr.P.C. The petitioner, if advised, may either file a criminal complaint or a civil suit.

With these observations, the present petition is disposed of.
